Covid-19 instruction in Belgium

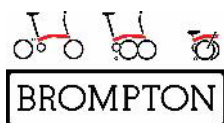
- You are allowed to move around freely.

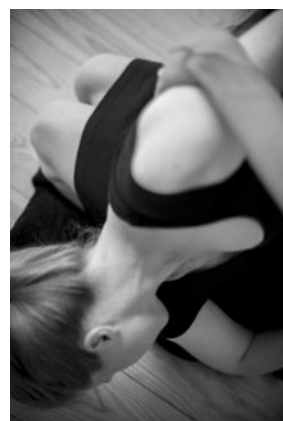
